## **Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held at The Village Hall, Over Haddon**

Mr Jonty Wood of 3 Monyash Road attended regarding access to the rear of his property via the private road leading to the allotments.

Mr Wood stated that plans had been passed for the building of a garden room & gymnasium at the top of his garden and requested access via the private road for machinery to dig out and lay the footings, and also for the removal of earth and other waste. As access has already been used, it was agreed that the Parish Council would send a letter to Mr Wood stating the conditions upon which he is able to use the road and specifying a time limit of 2 months for permission of access to put his base in and rebuild the block wall.
